

Updated Meeting Guidelines & Service Changes

Due to the recent rise in COVID-19 numbers, ISBC Staff and the Deacon Family Ministry would like to re-implement these guidelines:

1. Starting Dec 20th, we will go back to 2 Sunday Morning Worship Services only. There will be NO Sunday School, Evening Services or Wednesday Night Services (subject to change).
2. Sunday Morning Worship Services will be: @ 9:00 & 10:30 (subject to change). The songs and message will be the same in both services.
3. We ask for those in a High-Risk category and those age 60 and above to attend the 9:00 service (this is a suggestion only).
4. The Worship Center doors (front and back) will open 15 minutes prior to each service.
5. Only the Worship Center will be open, and the 4 restrooms will be available.
6. The Worship Center will be sanitized before and after each service including doorknobs and handles.
7. Hand sanitizer, wipes and masks will be available at the entrances of the Worship Center.
8. Attendees will be seated following social distancing guidelines (family units are encouraged to sit together).
9. Attendees may wear masks and gloves if they so choose (this is not a requirement).
10. Attendees are advised not to engage in shaking hands or other physical contact.
11. There will be no nursery or child-care provided (please bring your children to Worship).
12. There will not be a choir or a printed order of worship.
13. Offering plates will be on tables located near the exit doors of the Worship Center.
14. The 2 water fountains located in the back of the Worship Center will be out of order.
15. We ask that anyone who is SICK, has symptoms of COVID-19 illness, or anyone who has recently come in contact with someone with COVID-19 to forego our in-person gathering and worship with us online at www.isbclaurel.com or on Facebook.
16. During this COVID-19 pandemic, no one is under any obligation to attend services until they feel the time is appropriate for them to do so.
